A Reflection from the desk of the Pastor

Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

February 6, 2022

Year C

In the first reading, we are presented with the sending of Isaiah. Like Jeremiah, Isaiah was quick to point out his limitations, "*For I am a man of unclean lips, living among a people of unclean lips...*" However, since God had called Isaiah to be his messenger, God strengthened and enabled him by using a seraphim to purify him. Then, Isaiah heard the voice of the Lord and responded positively to God's call. There is a great lesson to be learned here. When God calls someone to be his messenger, no limitations prevent him from using that person. It is the grace of God that is at work in his messengers.

In the second reading, St. Paul also acknowledges the fact that God's grace is at work in him. He recounts how he was previously a persecutor of Christians. He also says he was the least of the apostles. The grace of God is something we cannot afford to take for granted. We need to recognize the fact that no human limitations can prevent God's will from coming to fruition. Are we open to the grace of God in our lives? Are we willing to respond positively to God's call to be his messengers?

Please pray for the repose of the soul of Msgr. James Margason. He was the Pastor of Corpus Christi Parish, Shiloh, and St. Joseph Parish, Lebanon. May his soul rest in perfect peace. Amen.

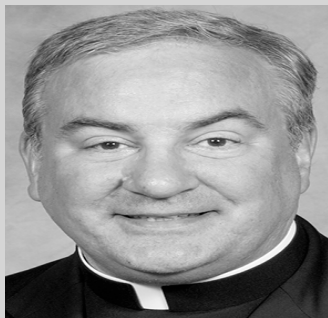

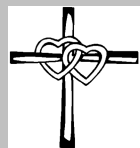

We pray to you, asking that you grant us more priests and religious who will help us build up your Church in the Diocese of Belleville and the world.

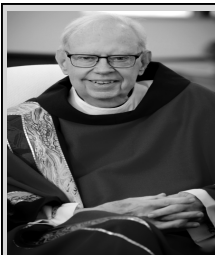

The Diocese of Belleville is seeking a part-time (20 hours per week) Director of the Respect Life Apostolate (RLA) to educate Catholics on the issues surrounding the Catholic Church's teachings regarding the dignity of the human person and sanctity of human life. The Director provides leadership for the RLA and works towards collaboration among offices and agencies within the Curia. The Director supervises, develops, and directs the Office in fulfilling the three-fold mission: to educate, to advocate, and to provide pastoral and spiritual programs that protect and respect human life from conception to natural death. The Director empowers parishes and schools to form strong respect life ministry programs by providing support and resources. The Director oversees the coordination of respect life activities and programs within the diocese, represents the diocese at the Illinois Catholic Conference and the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) Pro-Life Secretariat; and establishes a working relationship with the media, as well as with other pro-life organizations. The Director takes direction from the Bishop, the Illinois Catholic Conference, and the USCCB. He/she serves as an advisor to the Bishop. Essential qualifications include being a practicing Catholic; Bachelor's Degree preferred, or equivalent experience; and 1-3 years' experience in a related role plus knowledge in Microsoft Office and other computer programs/applications. 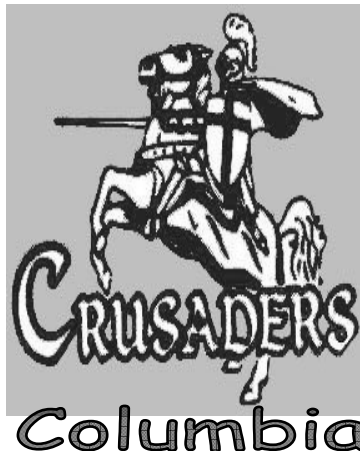
