## *A Reflection from the desk of the Pastor*

**The Most Holy Trinity June 12, 2022 Year C**



Our Christian life begins in the name of the Trinity. At our baptism, we are asked to profess our belief in the Trinity. The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the hierarchy of the truths of faith.

The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites those who turn away from sin." By calling God Father, the language of faith indicates that God is the origin of everything and transcendent authority. It also indicates that God is at the same time goodness and loving care for all his children. God's parental tenderness can be expressed by the image of motherhood.

In speaking to Philip of his relation to the father, Jesus states that "to have seen me is to have seen the Father. The Father and I are one." Following the apostolic tradition, the Church confessed at the First ecumenical council at Nicea that the Son is consubstantial with the Father, that is, one only God with him.

The Holy Spirit was spoken of by Jesus as the Advocate. The advocate would teach them and guide them to the complete truth. In the creed, when we speak of the Holy Spirit, we say "who proceeds from the Father and the Son. Together with the Father and the Son, he is adored and glorified.

In the Trinity, we do not confess three Gods, but one God in three persons.

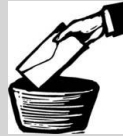

**About the News Story.** Here is the gospel declaration, the Good News for today. Who? Father, Son, and Spirit – aka (1) the Trinity and (2) God. What? The love of God has already been poured into us. When? Before creation and throughout our salvation down to today. Why? Because we stand in God's good grace by God's loving design. How? Ah, that is mystery!

- What peace does the Father bring this day?
- What does Jesus have to tell me about affliction, endurance, character, hope, and love (see the Romans reading)?
- How will I let the Spirit guide me?

## The Miraculous Byzantine Icon of OUR MOTHER OF PERPETUAL HELP

In 1861 the lost miraculous Byzantine icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help was found. Five years later, Pope Pius IX entrusted the icon to the care of the Redemptorists commissioning the Redemptorists to make her known throughout the world.

One of the first ten duplicates of the icon is enshrined at St. Alphonsus Liguori “Rock” Church on Grand Boulevard in St. Louis, Missouri. In 1871 that a novena to Our Mother of Perpetual Help was first offered at Rock Church. It was from St. Alphonsus Church in St. Louis that the novena spread throughout the world by means of the Redemptorists.

In 1922 the Redemptorists began offering a weekly devotion to Our Mother of Perpetual Help at the Rock. There were times, for example during World War II, that the City of St. Louis ran special bus lines on Tuesdays to Rock Church to handle the crowds of people who came to the devotional prayers. Many older Catholics who grew up in St. Louis testify to those days when as children they would travel by bus to St. Alphonsus with their mothers for the weekly devotions.

2022 marks the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary when weekly devotions to Our Mother of Perpetual Help began at St. Alphonsus Liguori “Rock” Church. Like the original novena, weekly devotions to Our Mother of Perpetual Help also originated here at the Rock and spread throughout the world by way of the Redemptorists. For example, in Manila, Philippines, over 100,000 people come each week to the shrine of Our Mother of Perpetual Help for the devotional prayers.

Many parishes in the diocese have weekly devotions to Our Mother of Perpetual Help. That is why the Redemptorists want you to know some of the history surrounding the miraculous icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help and join us in person or by means of streaming for the June 21-23 Triduum in honor of Our Mother of Perpetual Help and for a special Mass of Celebration June 26 (June 27 is the Feast of Our Mother of Perpetual Help) with Bishop Bruce Lewandowski, C.Ss.R. Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Baltimore.
