## *A Reflection from the desk of the Pastor*

**The Thirteen Sunday in Ordinary Time      June 26, 2022      Year C**


Jesus' determination to travel to Jerusalem was not deterred by the knowledge that he would die there. The messengers that Jesus sent ahead of him to prepare the way continued the mission of John the Baptist. As Jesus and his disciples cross into the region of Samaria and enter a village, they are rejected. They are rejected more because of the enmity that existed between Jews and Samaritans. Interestingly, Jesus does not reciprocate the rejection. Rather, he displays a positive attitude towards them. When James and John observe the rejection, they ask if they should call down fire from heaven to consume the people. In doing so, they manifest a misunderstanding of Jesus' mission. Jesus, instead, would teach them forbearance, love, and mercy.

In the dialogues that follow, Jesus also speaks of the challenges associated with being one of his disciples. These include not having a place to stay, detaching oneself from one's family, and being resolute once the decision has been made to become a disciple. These challenges are not easy and are unavoidable. However, they are part and parcel of discipleship, and we must be aware of them. It would be important for us to embrace these challenges on our Christian journey rather than seek to avoid them.

The Very Reverend Nicholas G. Junker, Vicar Forane for the Metro-East Vicariate, received the body of Father Rascher on Tuesday, the 21st of June, 2022 at St. Mary Catholic Church, 218 West Kentucky, Trenton, Illinois.

The Liturgy of Christian Burial was celebrated on Wednesday, June 22, 2022. The Most Reverend Michael McGovern was the principal celebrant and the Reverend Monsignor David M. Darin served as homilist. Fr. Rascher was buried in St. Mary Cemetery. ## The Miraculous Byzantine Icon of OUR MOTHER OF PERPETUAL HELP

In 1861 the lost miraculous Byzantine icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help was found. Five years later, Pope Pius IX entrusted the icon to the care of the Redemptorists commissioning the Redemptorists to make her known throughout the world.

One of the first ten duplicates of the icon is enshrined at St. Alphonsus Liguori “Rock” Church on Grand Boulevard in St. Louis, Missouri. In 1871 that a novena to Our Mother of Perpetual Help was first offered at Rock Church. It was from St. Alphonsus Church in St. Louis that the novena spread throughout the world by means of the Redemptorists.

In 1922 the Redemptorists began offering a weekly devotion to Our Mother of Perpetual Help at the Rock. There were times, for example during World War II, that the City of St. Louis ran special bus lines on Tuesdays to Rock Church to handle the crowds of people who came to the devotional prayers. Many older Catholics who grew up in St. Louis testify to those days when as children they would travel by bus to St. Alphonsus with their mothers for the weekly devotions.

2022 marks the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary when weekly devotions to Our Mother of Perpetual Help began at St. Alphonsus Liguori “Rock” Church. Like the original novena, weekly devotions to Our Mother of Perpetual Help also originated here at the Rock and spread throughout the world by way of the Redemptorists. For example, in Manila, Philippines, over 100,000 people come each week to the shrine of Our Mother of Perpetual Help for the devotional prayers.

Many parishes in the diocese have weekly devotions to Our Mother of Perpetual Help. That is why the Redemptorists want you to know some of the history surrounding the miraculous icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help and join us in person or by means of streaming for the June 21-23 Triduum in honor of Our Mother of Perpetual Help and for a special Mass of Celebration June 26 (June 27 is the Feast of Our Mother of Perpetual Help) with Bishop Bruce Lewandowski, C.Ss.R. Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Baltimore.
